# What is a School Liaison?

- ▶ School Liaisons are the central point of contact for commanders, military families and school districts on Preschool-12<sup>th</sup> grade school matters. School Liaisons are the bridge between families, school communities and military installations.
- ▶ **School Liaison Areas of Support**
  - School Transition Support
    - Enrollment & Eligibility
    - Placement and Graduation Requirements
    - Special Education Services
  - Local School Navigation
    - Public, Private, Homeschool
    - Resources and Sponsorship

# What is a School Liaison?

- Deployment Support
  - Educator Awareness, Support Groups, Resources
- ▶ Military Interstate Children's Compact Commission (MIC3)
  - The Compact allows for uniform treatment as military children transfer between school districts in member states.
  - School Liaisons work closely with families and School Districts to ensure there is compliance with the Compact.
- ▶ Who do School Liaisons Serve?
  - School Liaisons provide support to Department of Defense (DoD) Total Force members.
  - Every service branch has school liaisons assigned to each installation to support service members with your child's educational needs
